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MPCA AmeriCorps Program

AmeriCorps is a national service program designed to strengthen citizenship and the ethics of service by engaging thousands of Americans on a full-time or part-time basis to help communities address their toughest challenges. The Michigan Primary Care Association (MPCA) HealthCorps program engages AmeriCorps service members in outreach to low-income and medically underserved populations and connecting them to primary healthcare at a community health center. Michigan HealthCorps members may also assist health centers in their community response to COVID-19.

MI HealthCorps Service Activities

- Outreach to connect low-income and medically underserved community members with primary healthcare services, including annual primary care visits, chronic disease management visits, or preventive services like immunizations and cancer screenings.
- Facilitate access to care by aiding with appointment scheduling, transportation assistance, and arranging interpretation. Connect patients with supportive community services to address social needs and barriers to care.
- Re-engage patients who experienced delayed or disrupted care due to COVID-19 and assisting with COVID-19 community testing and immunization events.
