EligibilityRequirements:

- Acceptance into a CODA accredited dental therapy program (scholarship applications will be accepted even if educational program acceptance is pending)
- Completed FAFSA for the academic year
- 2 letters of reference
- Must work as a dental therapist in Michigan for 3 years
